### Just Say "Yes" to Lent!

For in [Jesus Christ] every one of God's promises is a "Yes." For this reason it is through him that we say the "Amen," to the glory of God. 2 Corinthians 1:20 (New Revised Standard version)

Rev. Tom Berlin (pastor and Member of The Florida United Methodist Church) says, "Lent is a time for going more deeply into Christian discipleship. Church members are often aware that Lent is a season for increased devotion to Christ that lends itself to study, prayer, and introspection. So it is an ideal time to call the congregation to a deepening of their discipleship over the six weeks of Lent and to find ways to make these weeks welcoming to those who might be new to the church."

"This can begin with something as simple as reminding people of the importance of worship at this most holy time of year. Something is just not right if Christian people are not in church during Lent, Holy Week, and on Easter. Churches can be frank and gracious at the same time by talking about what people have experienced in Holy Week worship over the centuries and how much such worship can mean to their spiritual development...I've issued a 'Lent Challenge' to encourage my congregation to participate in worship and study during Lent. Many are in the habit of 'giving something up for Lent,' often an item like chocolate or dessert. While calories were fewer for the faithful, such discipline did little to transform lives. Besides, 'giving up' these things often left people dour and cranky, gateways into sins other than gluttony. Instead of 'giving up' sweets, church members were called to 'take up' the daily reading of scripture, involvement in a weekly small group, and participation in weekly worship. By infusing their lives with the reading of the Bible, Christian conversation, and six consecutive weeks of worship, they could truly honor Christ and seek a deeper faith experience during Lent."

So, let me challenge each one of us to not just "take up" something for Lent but rather (in the words of Bishop Robert Schnase), "Just say 'Yes'" to several things in this 40 day season between Ash Wednesday and Easter Sunday.

Bishop Schnase's concept of "Just say 'Yes'" delves "into the profound and transformative experience of saying Yes to Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit. Through this intimate connection, the Holy Spirit gives each person gifts. These gifts are crucial to the work of Christ in the world." <sup>2</sup>

As a means of saying "YES" to ourselves and our Lord Jesus, we offer the following Lent opportunities:

- ♦ Shrove Tuesday Mardi Gras Pancake Music Party, February 28th at 6 p.m. in the Fellowship Hall. (Featuring a pancake dinner and music by Broadstreet.)
- ♦ Ash Wednesday Service March 1st from 6-6:30 pm in the sanctuary. This is a service of confession and imposition of ashes (the ashes are optional).
- ◆ Lenten Luncheons Theme: "Just Say Yes" at Noon. Begins March 8 and goes through April 5<sup>th</sup>.

Every Wednesday **Night** at 6:30 beginning March 8 at various United Methodist Church, there will be a teaching series called: "The Kingdom of God is like..." (pastors teaching on the parables)

Sign-up sheets are in the church office or in the back of the sanctuary for the Shrove Tuesday Mardi Gras Party and The Lenten Luncheon (we could also use some volunteers).

### March 5, 2017 - First Sunday in Lent — Message: Just Say Yes to the Holy Spirit

This week we will delve into the profound and transformative experience of saying Yes to Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit. Through this intimate connection, the Holy Spirit gives each person gifts. These gifts are crucial to the work of Christ in the world. So this week's missional assumption is "everyone has gifts for ministry" as seen in Genesis 2:15-17; 3:1-7 - Fruit from the forbidden tree and Matthew 4:1-11 - Christ tempted in the desert for 40 days.

### March 12, 2017 - Second Sunday in Lent — Message: Just Say Yes to Your Calling

Building on week 1, this week's missional assumption is "God calls everyone to service and ministry" (57). Our focus will be discerning where your gifts, talents, and passions meet the deep needs of the world. In that intersection, you will find your calling. This is based on: Genesis 12:1-4 – Blessed to be a Blessing and John 3:1-17 – Nicodemus Gets his Bearings.

### March 19, 2017 - Third Sunday in Lent — Message: Just Say Yes to Growth


Saying Yes to Jesus Christ requires us to grow in knowledge of ourselves and who God created us to be. In order to do this, we must continually and intentionally live as disciples. Our missional assumption this week is "the ministries of the church should foster spiritual growth and disciple-ship" (59). This comes from Exodus 17:1-7 – Moses Follows the Directions and Gets Water from a Rock and John 4:5-42 – Woman at the well needs direction.

### March 26, 2017 - Fourth Sunday in Lent — Message: Just Say Yes to Encouragement

Our missional assumption is "the work of the church is to encourage people in their callings" (62). Bishop Schnase calls this a "permission-giving" culture. Each church member can be part of building this type of church. "The most direct and personal way to contribute to a permission-giving environment is through offering the ministry of encouragement" (112). This message comes from 1 Samuel 16:1-13 & John 9:1-41.

### **A Journey with Christ**

"While they were talking and discussing, Jesus himself came near and walked with them." (Luke 24:15)

Both the Walk to Emmaus (for adults), Journey (for young adults) and Chrysalis (for High School Sophomores–Seniors who are 16–19) weekends are experiences of Christian spiritual renewal and formation that begins with a three-day short course in Christianity. It is an opportunity to meet Jesus Christ in a new way as God's grace and love is revealed to you through other believers.

The Walk to Emmaus, Journey and Chrysalis weekend experiences begin with the prayerful discernment and invitation from a sponsor. After one accepts this invitation they complete an application. The Emmaus leaders prayerfully consider each applicant and in God's time, the person is invited to attend a three-day experience of New Testament Christianity as a lifestyle. (Please talk with Richard & Grace Barron or Fred & Kaye Ball or Carl & Lynn Varner for sponsorship.)

Following the three-day experience, participants are joined in small groups to support each other in their ongoing walk with Christ.

Through the formational process of accountable discipleship in small groups and participation in the Emmaus community, each participant's individual gifts and servant-leadership skills are developed for use in the local church and its mission. Participants are encouraged to find ways to live out their individual call to discipleship in their home, church, and community.

The objective of Emmaus is to inspire, challenge, and equip the local church members for Christian action in their homes, churches, communities and places of work. 

As you are aware there is a growing population of homeless in our community. Although our temperatures do not compare to those of the north, we do experience cold temperatures for sleeping outdoors.

We are asking for donations of blankets. When belongings get wet they are useless for keeping someone warm and it can take days for items to dry out.

As you go through your closets this year and find you have unused blankets and/or garments that you could spare, please bring them to the church office and they will be distributed and greatly appreciated.

If you wish to help out with the emergency shelter for homeless neighbors, the DAV on Singleton Road has agreed to be their place to stay whenever the drops below 40 degrees F. They need a hot meal that will feed 6 to 8 persons. If you want to stay as a volunteer, we will orient you there.


